The above boat allocations apply for the first two rounds, after which teams may be reallocated so as to endeavour to equalise the number of times teams compete against each other.

This schedule has been adopted to minimise the time lost with multiple change overs after each race, and also to give teams a maximum of 5 races on the water before being followed by a three race break ashore at CYCSA.

Teams are reminded to be at the Changeover Marshalling Area (End of A/B Row) and ready to depart no later than the Start Signal of the race immediately preceding their scheduled race. (SI 14.4d).
